Dear Friends,

HEPHZIBAH HAS A LONG HISTORY OF GROWTH AND INNOVATION IN TIMES OF CRISIS. This was true in 1897, when our founder, Mary Wessels, opened her Oak Park home to two young children—and quickly made space for a dozen more after a local orphanage was destroyed by fire. It was true after the stock market crash of 1929—when the brick dormitory building now known as Hephzibah Home was completed just in time to serve

as a haven for Depression-era children whose parents could no longer afford to care for them. It was true in the 1940s, when children found a safe harbor at Hephzibah while their fathers were off at war.

It was also true in Fiscal Year 2020 as we weathered the COVID-19 crisis while providing more services for more children and families than ever before—a feat that would not have been possible without the extraordinary dedication and creativity of our staff and board members and the generosity and commitment of a caring community of benefactors and volunteers.

Our year of growth, ingenuity and creativity began with the launch of *Family Matters*, a strategic plan that will guide us over the next four years as we **expand our reach and enhance our services** to strengthen families and give children the best possible start in life.

The loss of one's biological family, however fragile or flawed it may be, is a wound that lasts a lifetime. To **help and heal families in crisis**, *before* they reach the breaking point and their children must be removed from the only home they have ever known, we **provided support**

and intervention services for 174 intact families—the largest number of intact family cases in Hephzibah's history. As the number of Illinois families struggling with stressors such as poverty, unemployment, chronic illness and homelessness continues to grow, this strategic objective has become an urgent priority—one that we will address by doubling the number of families that we serve in Fiscal Year 2021.

As we deepened and broadened our core work of keeping families together, we laid the groundwork for the integration of the Positive Parenting Program into our Intact Family Services. This evidence-based parenting and family support model—which enhances the knowledge, skills and confidence of parents to reduce the prevalence of emotional and behavioral problems in children—has been shown to cut

rates of child abuse, reduce foster care placements and decrease hospitalizations from child abuse injuries.¹

While we expanded our services for families, we provided a safe haven and a place to heal for 35 neglected and abused children in our **Diagnostic Treatment Center** and **Residence** at Hephzibah Home. In Fiscal Year 2020, the Department of Children and Family Services **recognized** these highly specialized programs for their successful outcomes by designating them as the only programs licensed to serve the most severely traumatized children between the ages of three and eleven in the state of Illinois. This new

designation provided additional funding for a full-time behavioral analyst hired in September 2020, as well as enhanced therapeutic services, additional caseworkers and a higher staff-to-child ratio to help children recover from the devastating effects of extreme abuse and neglect.

Because **every foster child deserves a loving family with no expiration date**, we also intensified our efforts to achieve permanency for the children in our care by adding a clinical supervisor, a licensing supervisor, a foster care supervisor and a sixth part-time therapist to our foster care team. You'll learn more about the tireless efforts of this team—which helped **more Hephzibah foster children achieve permanency than ever before**—and experience the joy of one of these happy endings as you meet a Hephzibah "forever family" on page eight of this report.

When Chicago became a COVID-19 hotspot in Spring 2020, **keeping children safe and families strong took on a whole new meaning**. As has been our tradition for more than 120 years, we swiftly pivoted to meet this global health crisis head on. By carefully and creatively

reallocating our resources and shifting employees from our temporarily suspended after-school Day Care program to areas of critical need, we were able to keep our entire staff on payroll, continue our core programming and provide pandemic-related emergency relief services where they were needed most.

In this report, you'll learn more about our efforts to meet the academic, therapeutic and recreational needs of the 26 energetic children sheltering in place at Hephzibah Home and develop a **full-day, socially distanced summer camp experience** that was, literally and figuratively, a breath of fresh air for 99 school-age campers and their families.

This letter would not be complete without a mention of the heroes who helped us navigate the "new

Coping with COVID-19

Behind the scenes at Hephzibah Home during the coronavirus

IN SPRING 2020, KEEPING KIDS SAFE at Hephzibah Home took on a whole new meaning as Chicago became a COVID-19 hotspot and a tiny but formidable pathogen transformed our lives. Here's how we kept them

connected, educated, active, enriched and entertained during the first months of the COVID-19 pandemic.

You can always tell it's a weekday morning when the school buses line up outside of Hephzibah Home. But the bus lane was empty during the final months of the fiscal year as the children in our Diagnostic Treatment Center and Residence at Hephzibah Home embarked on a new adventure in virtual learning.

"It was challenging at first," admits Hephzibah Education Coordinator Eliana Callan. "We had 26 different learning plans on different devices and platforms and more Zoom meetings than I could count."

With more than two dozen children to educate and a lot of special needs to address, Callan and her coworkers spun into action. "It was an all-handson-deck situation," she recalls. "Our goal was to

help the children stay connected to school and to the teachers who had become such an important part of their lives."

After a short adjustment period, the children adapted surprisingly well to their virtual classrooms and continued to make academic progress—a fact that Callan attributes to the dedication of a committed group of Oak Park educators.

"We have so many stories about these amazing educators who went out of their way to help our kids," Callan notes. "The teachers dropped off schoolwork, made short videos to keep the children motivated and even organized a drive-by parade to let them know how much they were missed."

Meanwhile, our therapists were hard at work helping the children cope with the emotional impact of COVID-19.

"Many of the children have a history of relational trauma and broken family bonds," says Hephzibah

pandemic

Clinical Supervisor Ashley Ice. "So our first priority was to preserve the nurturing and supportive relationships that these children had developed with Hephzibah therapists, social workers, staff and volunteers."

But how does one safely stay connected during a global pandemic?

"Connection is connection, whether it's virtual or in real life," says Ice. "We masked up for in-person therapy sessions and encouraged the children to talk about their feelings of loss and isolation. We also encouraged them to use the coping tools that they had learned upon their arrival at Hephzibah—tools that had helped them become more resilient, such as meditation, breathing exercises, yoga and positive self-talk."

Throughout the lockdown, our volunteer Big Siblings and Heartmates stayed in touch via phone calls, letters and Zoom sessions; our Homework Helpers read stories to the children on video; and our Paws for Strength pet therapists shared entertaining videos showing the world from a pup's point of view.

With many pre-pandemic recreational outings and extracurricular activities suspended, we also had a lot of empty hours to fill.

"We wanted to keep the kids busy and active after their schoolwork was done," explains Hephzibah Behavioral Interventionist Molly Pyne. "So we came up with an extensive menu of afternoon activities, from indoor sports such as bowling and hockey to freezedance competitions and karaoke."

With each extension of the stay-at-home order, our staff members brainstormed again to keep the fun fresh and the surprises coming—from build-yourown robots to a crazy hair day with spray-on hair colors.

"Even though we were not leaving Hephzibah Home and life was far from normal," says Pyne, "the kids were having fun every single day and so were we."

Saving Summer

Peace of mind for working parents during the summer of COVID

As Oak Park families hunkered down at home during the pandemic's early stages in March and April, Hephzibah's Day Care staff was already thinking ahead.

Summer was just weeks away, COVID-19 was still a serious threat to lives and livelihoods—and summer camps and activities were being canceled one by one. Many parents who didn't have the option of working at home—from first responders and health care workers to grocery store employees—were facing a summer without adequate or affordable child care.

With these parents in mind, our Day Care team was working overtime to create **Summer**

Hephzibah 2020—a full-day, socially distanced summer camp experience for a world in the grip of a global pandemic.

"For more than 40 years, Hephzibah has provided exceptional after-school and summer camp day care experiences for generations of children of working parents—and we were committed to continuing that tradition during the COVID-19 pandemic," says Day Care Director Amy O'Rourke. "Although we reimagined our

summer camp experience in 2020 to follow the safety protocols outlined by the Centers for Disease Control, the American Camp Association and the Illinois Department of Public Health, our missionbound commitment to providing safe, enriching and affordable day care on a sliding scale for families of all income levels did not change."

By June 8, Summer Hephzibah 2020 was in full swing, offering peace of mind for working parents and a full menu of summer fun for 99 school-aged

"The children were champions about adjusting to the protocols established to keep them safe during the pandemic," says O'Rourke. "If the children were wearing their masks correctly, they earned 'Masked Crusader' points. If they were standing six feet apart, they got points for keeping their 'Force Field' up. These points could be swapped for small prizes, a spontaneous dance party, a guest singer and other incentives."

Our summer campers' daily dose of fun included outdoor sports, cooking projects, picnics, karaoke, singing parades, scavenger hunts, canoeand teepee-building projects, dance challenges, silly sock days, water play, outdoor science fairs, bike rides and scooter outings.

Some of the fun—like our "drive-in theater" day with cars made out of cardboard boxes—was charmingly retro, but some was decidedly high-tech, such as a Tik-Tok video produced by the children and Zoom Lego Mindstorm robotics classes offered in partnership with the Oak Park Education

One of the silver linings of the pandemic, according to O'Rourke, was the opportunity for our summer camp counselors to enjoy more one-onone time with the children. "Without the field trips, the pool days and the playshops, there was more time to bond with our summer campers," she says. "On some days, our Day Care staff brought in their musical instruments and played music for the kids. It was a pretty calm and fun summer overall."

Forever Families

Why every foster child needs a safe and loving forever home

"ALL CHILDREN—and especially older children in foster care—need and deserve a loving family with no expiration date. Yet, in the U.S., more than 23,000

youth exit foster care and are left to fend for themselves each year. This scenario—leaving foster care without achieving permanence—carries lifelong consequences. Youth who age out of foster care are more likely to engage in risky behaviors and experience hardships such as homelessness, joblessness, early parenthood and substance use."

This statement from the Annie E. Casey Foundation is supported by statistics released

by the National Foster Youth Institute, which tell us that 20 percent of foster youth will become homeless on the day they age out of foster care, only half will have gainful employment by the age of 24 and fewer than three percent will earn a college degree. Without the support of a forever family, foster children trying to heal from a traumatic past may face an equally tragic future.

According to Hephzibah Executive Director Merry Beth Sheets, these outcomes can be avoided if child

welfare agencies are proactive about helping children achieve permanency while they are in care. "Every child deserves a safe, loving and permanent home where they can be unconditionally loved and receive the support they need to succeed," she states. "We want every child in a safe home with a permanent family. That is our number one goal."

In Fiscal Year 2020, 25 Hephzibah foster children achieved permanency-more than ever before in our foster care program. Yet supporting the development of forever families that can weather the emotional storms caused by a child's early trauma is a long and complex process—one that involves

intensive counseling for emotionally fragile foster children; training and ongoing support for family members; and a dedicated staff committed to going the extra mile to achieve each

permanency in a timely manner while ensuring the long-term success of the family unit.

In recent years, Hephzibah has launched a concerted effort to lay the groundwork for these forever families.

"A few years ago, we added two new caseworkers, a clinical advocate and a permanency specialist to our Foster Care team," says Director of Family Based Services Julie Dvorsky. "In Fiscal 2020, we expanded our team with a clinical supervisor, a licensing supervisor, a foster care supervisor and a sixth parttime therapist. The tireless efforts of these dedicated professionals is reflected in the historic number of permanencies that we achieved—a 150-percent increase since 2017."

"When a family is given the necessary services and support to ensure their child's continued wellbeing, that's a strong foundation and a beautiful start to a forever family," says Permanency Specialist Alexandria McCague. "Parents and children who have gone through this process with us know that we are

part of that forever family—and that we are standing by to provide the support and encouragement they need as they build a life together."

Zander, a bright and introspective 13-year-old, is just one beneficiary of Hephzibah's permanency initiative. In foster care from the age of four, he was adopted by Oak Parkers Monica Tijerina and Mark Rauckhorst in Fall 2019.

"To make Zander feel more secure and help us move forward as a family, a Hephzibah therapist came to our home on a weekly basis," recalls Monica. "Hephzibah also provided a therapeutic mentor and ongoing parenting training, covered the cost of tutoring to address Zander's academic deficits and even paid for private swimming lessons."

As Zander's adoption date approached, his anxiety skyrocketed and his behaviors escalated. "Hephzibah's foster care team was very responsive," says Monica. "Sometimes they were at our house so often that it felt like they lived here!"

After the adoption, Zander began to relax as it dawned on him that he finally had a forever home.

"Now, Zander says to me 'I know I'm here forever and if I do things wrong, I know you won't stop loving me," Mark confides. "This is the first time in his life that he's had that feeling of security."

Today, when Zander acts out like any other teenager, Monica reassures him even as she reigns him in.

"I tell him, 'For better or for worse, you're here forever—so you'd better shape up!" she says with a laugh. "Overall, we're a pretty tight family unit."

The Chicago Bears' 100th-Season Surprise

WHAT'S BETTER than serving as an honorary captain at Soldier Field during the Chicago Bears' pre-game coin toss?

According to Hephzibah Board President Kenna MacKinnon and Executive Director Merry Beth Sheets, it doesn't get much better than that—unless you also receive a \$100,000 check from the Chicago Bears Community All-Pros grant program.

The moment was a dream come true for our fearless board president and executive director, who boldly strode out onto Soldier Field to accept the check in front of FOX News cameras and thousands of football fans before an October 2019 matchup between the Chicago Bears and the New Orleans Saints.

The Community All-Pros program was launched

to celebrate the Chicago Bears' 100th season and express the Bears' gratitude to the community that has supported the team since 1921. Ten \$100,000 Community All-Pros grants were awarded over the course of the 2019 season to support nonprofits that do meaningful work in the Chicago area.

"This gift will have a tremendous impact on the lives of the young children who call Hephzibah their home each year," reports Sheets. "It tells our children that the entire Chicago Bears family believes in them and stands with them as they heal from the trauma of abuse and neglect."





through a continuum of communitybased programs that include shortterm and long-term group homes for neglected and abused children, foster care and adoption services, comprehensive services for children and families in crisis and after-school day care services on a sliding scale for families of all income levels.

Hephzibah is accredited

by the National Council on Accreditation for Children and Family Services, Inc. and the National Association for the Education of Young Children.

Licensing

Hephzibah is licensed by the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services as a Child Welfare Agency, Group Home and Child Care Institution.

Funding

Hephzibah receives state funding from the Illinois Department of Children and Family Services, the Department of Human Services and the State Board of Education. Local funding is received from the Village of Oak Park, Oak Park School District 97, Oak Park Township and River Forest Township. Head Start funding is received from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services through Children's Home + Aid. Funding is also received from United Way and our own fundraising activities.


